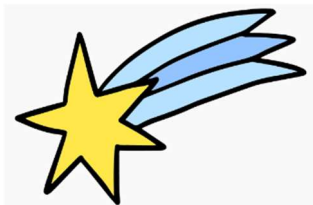

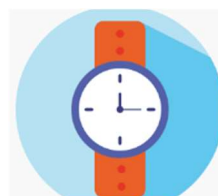
After School Clubs
