

Read Fluently

To be able to recognise and understand words, sentences and more detailed writing in the target language, using knowledge acquired at different stages of Spanish learning.

Write imaginatively

To be able to use knowledge of phonics, nouns, grammar and language learning to create and produce writing in the target language, using knowledge acquired at different stages of Spanish learning.

Understand Culture

To understand the customs, and social behaviours of a particular people, society or country explored through popular religious beliefs, customs, food and music.

Speak confidently

To use knowledge acquired at different stages of Spanish learning to speak in the target language.

Listen attentively

To listen to lessons in the target lessons to acquire knowledge and skills for language learning.

To use knowledge of phonics and phonemes and how they apply to language learning.

To listen to lessons in Spanish lessons, to acquire understanding of the pronunciation of letters and words in the target language.

Phonics

The system of the sounds of a language and how these are represented in written words. It is the pronunciation of letters and sounds in the target language.

Feminine Noun

In the Spanish language there are feminine nouns, which refer to the gender of the noun.

Cognate

Words in a foreign language that look similar to English.

Vocabulary

Building a body of useful words for different contexts and situations to enable communication and understanding.

Grammar

Including syntax (arrangement of words) and inflectional features, i.e., the systems for changing the form of a word (singular to plural) and for creating new words respectively.

Masculine

In the Spanish language there are masculine nouns, which refer to the gender of the noun.
