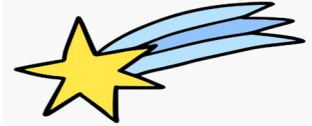

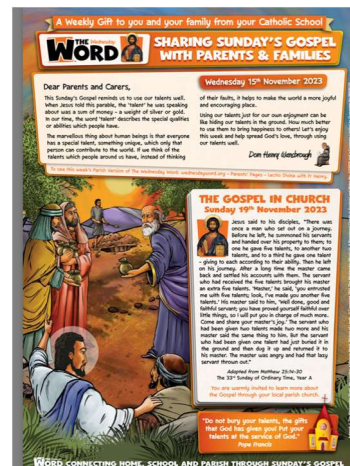
Reading Book Amnesty

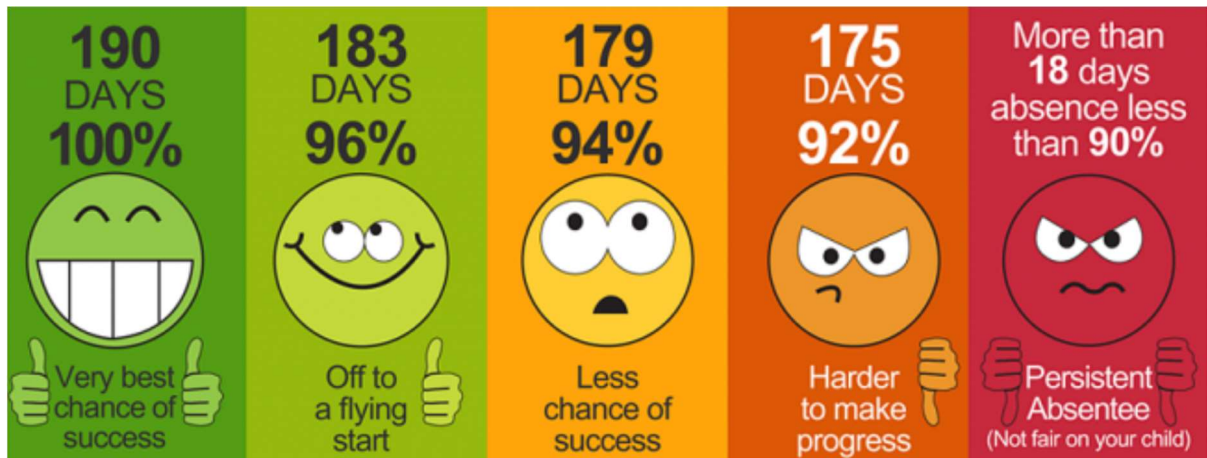

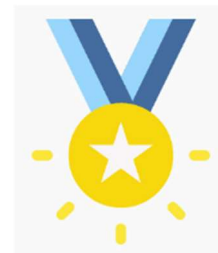

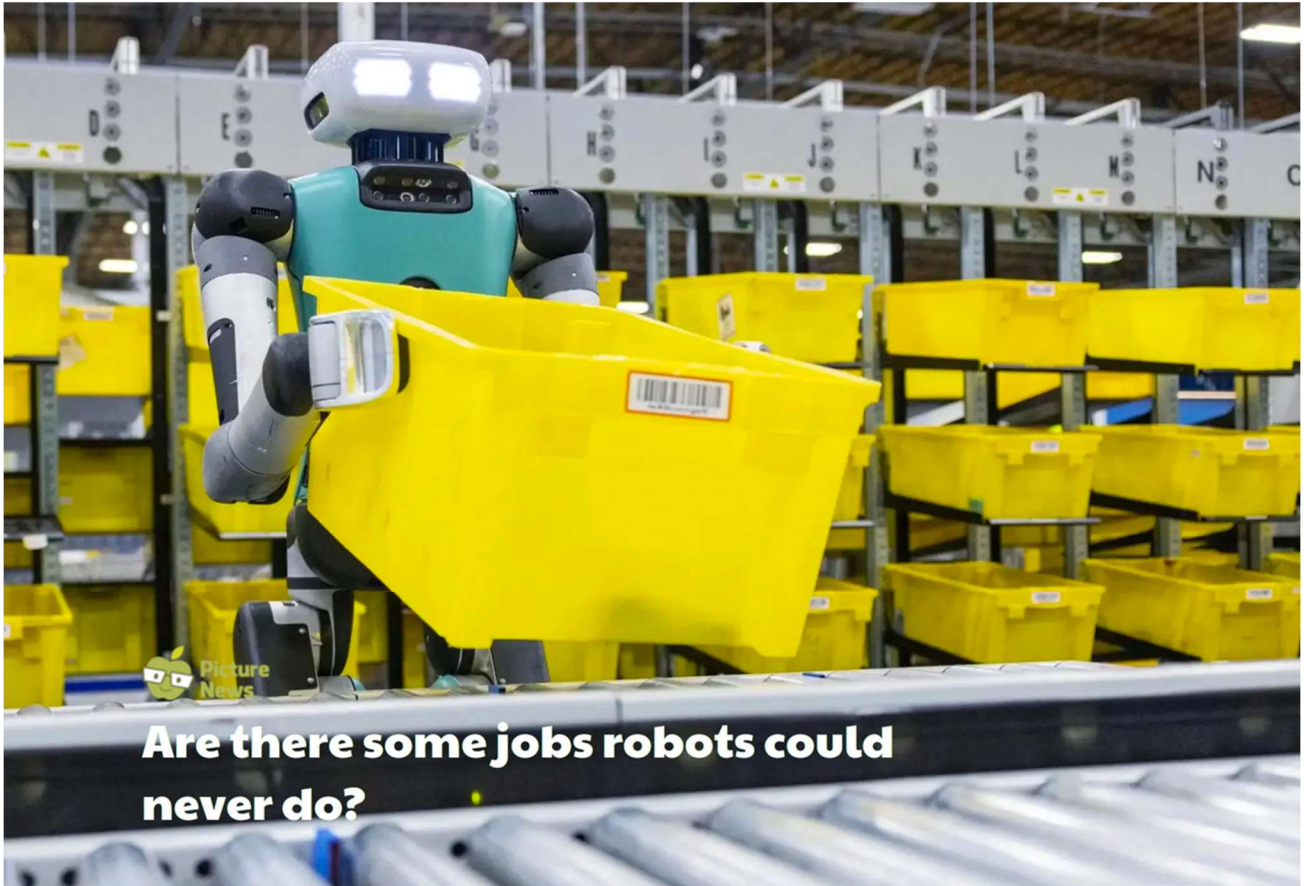


Date for Your Diary
